Importance of her research

Acquired resistance to antibiotics by bacteria has become a challenge for science and medicine, limiting the therapeutic options for highly prevalent infections in the hospital setting and in the community. Developing pharmacological strategies that avoid these resistance mechanisms would be a breakthrough in combating certain bacterial infections.
